





# Strategic Health Support Program for Iraqi Refugees Residing in Jordan

Provision of primary, secondary, pharmaceuticals, and psychosocial health care services

- Home outreach program providing basic health services and referrals to Iraqi refugee families in Amman, Irbid and Zarqa
- 40,000 health care visits to partner clinics
- Pharmaceuticals provided for 70% of vulnerable patients

#### UNHCR funded Outreach Services Project for Iraqi Refugees

- Identification of vulnerable refugees and referral to UNHCR services
- Provision of material and service assistance to Persons of Concern
- Increase awareness of rights and services and encourage participation in service delivery

# Community-Based Support Program for Iraqi Refugees Residing in Jordan

- Vocational Training
- Day Care Centers
- Home Production
- Healthy Lifestyles



**Target:** 600 men to be trained in Automotive, Computer Software and Hardware, Plumbing, Electrical Installation, Recycling, Gardening, Catering, Construction.







# Community Mobilization for Partnership in Jordan Schools Program

- Community participation in the design, implementation, and monitoring of school improvement efforts through Community Parent School Committees (CPSC)
- Strengthened community school support connections, offering life-long learning opportunities and extracurricular programs within schools
- Increased community awareness, responsibility, and advocacy for education
