« WiFi + XOs = better education for Nosy Komba »





For 3 years, associations OLPC France and G du Cœur run a 160 XOs deployment on the Island of **Nosy Komba**, a little island in the north west of Madagascar. Today, all the children of the primary school have their own pedagogical device and the 6 teachers were trained to the laptop use.

This year we are going further, we will bring the Internet to the children. Our goals:

- Allow kids and teachers to access educational resources on the web,
- Update and deploy new content easily,
- Facilitate monitoring and project assistance from France.

Our team is led by an engineer on networks and embedded systems. After different studies and quotations in 2010 we decided to choose an innovative solution based on long-range WiFi.

The principle is to use an ADSL connection from the nearby island of Nosy Be and to broadcast the network by WiFi directional amplification to the island of Nosy Komba located to 12km.

This sort of Long-range WiFi was already used in some OLPC deployment (i.e. Afghanistan) or in low cost web access solution in developing countries.

A test scale on 15km is planned to the battle mesh OpenWrt Barcelona and another one will be done around Paris in April.
