## <u>Ground Transportation</u> (Dakar, Senegal<--> Tdjikja, Mauritania)

Dakar->St. Louis->Rosso (4200 CFA + luggage = ~5000CFA per person) \* 3 people = \$30 \* 2 (Round trip) = \$60

Rosso (Mauritanian side)->Nouakchott->Tidjikja = 6200 Ouguiyas \* 3 people = \$75 \* 2 (Round trip) = \$150

Extra expenditure due to the need to rent an entire taxi to bring laptops from Nouakchott to Tdjikja = \$250

Ground transportation total = \$460

#### TECHNOLOGY EXPENSES
