What can go wrong

No "Release the game key" message

possibly you didn't get all the game keys at once power off again go back to 1) Prepare

possibly the USB connection has issues

Try again by plugging in the flash memory to another XO port

If after trying several times this doesn't work, suspect the USB flash files are bad. Replace the USB or the files

No grid or an"unhappy" yellow smiley



If you did get the "Release game key" message, <u>but</u> no grid after a couple minutes, or an "unhappy" smiley, start again trying another USB port.

If still no go, suspect the USB flash files are bad - replace

No reboot, no power light (green or orange)

If you got the "Release game key" message, then the grid, but no automatic reboot, check the power charger is plugged in correctly, reboot manually by pressing the power button once the power light comes on

Computers that have been blocked will not reflash

Reflash / upgrade your XO

This will reinstall Sugar, erasing everything on your XO!

which might be exactly what you want if you are donating your XO, for example, or upgrading to a new release of Sugar



When you're done, your XO will reboot automatically and ask you for a name, as if it were brand new

You will need a USB with Sugar files

Make your own

You will need a 512 MB or larger USB memory stick. Some people have reported issues with sticks over 4 Gb.

a USB flash memory stick already loaded with Sugar upgrade files



an XO laptop




power charger for the XO laptop

plug the USB stick

into any one of the

1) Prepare








Start with your XO, Plug your XO to its power charger. This should turn on the three USB ports. "power" light to green or orange.

no blinking lights, no power light.

If necessary, remove the battery.

2) Go





be sure to get all four.



while still holding the four keep holding down the gamepad keys, push the power button to turn the XO on.

You may need your other hand to do this.

Let go the power button right away or the XO will turn off again



four gamepad keys until the message "Release the game key to continue" appears on the screen.

This will happen fairly quickly, a few seconds at most.

Let go the gamepad keys.

3) Done



If after a few seconds you see a grid of black and colored boxes on your screen, congratulations!

Your XO is reflashing

If not, start again. (unplug and turn off, etc).



Just sit back and let it your XO will do its thing.

It will take about 10 minutes



automatically reboot when it is done.

Your XO may reboot twice, playing the little XO tune both times, and then ask you for a name.

You may remove the USB flash at any moment now.
